

**CITY OF SAULT STE. MARIE  
RESOLUTION FOR SUBMISSION OF A  
PORT INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM GRANT (PIDP)**

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Transportation has issued a Notice of Funding Opportunity for the Maritime Administration's Port Infrastructure Development Program (PIDP) under the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act ("Bipartisan Infrastructure Law"); and

**WHEREAS**, if received these funds would be used improve vehicular and pedestrian safety, realign the dock entrance at Salmon Run Way with Ord Street, storm water drainage improvement and replacement of underground utilities for the Carbide Dock Port and Easterday Avenue Truck Route; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sault Ste. Marie wishes to apply for \$3,300,000 in funding understanding that of the total project budget of \$4,300,000, the City is committing to provide \$1,000,000 in matching funds, which will be funded by the Michigan Department of Transportation Carbide Dock Grant; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Sault Ste. Marie hereby designates the City Manager as the Certifying Officer, the person authorized to certify the PIDP Application, the person authorized to sign the Grant Agreement and payment requests, and the person authorized to execute any additional documents required to carry out and complete the grant.
