Public Content

BACKGROUND:

The Street Department is in need of a new street sweeper. We currently have 2 units, a 2000 and 2007 model year. The purchase of this unit will replace the 2000 sweeper, which is well beyond its intended useful life. The proposed unit was demoed last year and handled our conditions well as there was a mix of snow and rain coupled with plenty of leaves in the roadway.

ANALYSIS:

This was put out for bid following the City's purchasing policy and 1 company submitted 3 bids of various versions. A bid tabulation and bidder documents are attached.

It is the recommendation of administration that the City purchase the 3rd option, which is the second lowest bid price model from MTech Company.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH: (if applicable)

Bids were posted publicly per the purchasing policy.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The purchase of this new street sweeper was budgeted for in the Capital Equipment Improvements for the current fiscal year. The selected bid is within the budgeted amount of \$400,000. The remaining \$48,500 will remain in the Stock & Equipment Capital


Equipment budget to offset other capital equipment bids that have come in overbudget due to the shortage of vehicle stock at dealerships. Each overage is described in the agenda memo and available prior to the bid award by City Commission.
