BACKGROUND:

The Pullar Community Building has 2 steam boilers from the 1980's that are in need of being replaced as they have extended their useful life. This capital improvement was approved during the 2023-24 CIP process with a budget of \$250,000. UPEA was contracted for professional services for the engineering, bidding, and construction administration to oversee this project and bidding was completed in mid-January 2024, with a proposed project construction timeline for summer 2024.

ANALYSIS:

Bids were received from 2 different contractors. A bid tabulation sheet is attached as well as their bid documents.

It is the recommendation of City administration, along with its engineers at UPEA, to award the bid to the low bidder, Berger & King. See letter of recommendation from UPEA attached.
