- 2. City Staff will contact you to further discuss your application and document what your plans are.
- 3. Proposals for larger projects will require the Adopt-a-Park Project Application.
- 4. The application and plan documents will be brought to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board for recommendation.
- 5. After approval by the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board, any necessary waivers or agreements will be executed.
